Talk about It

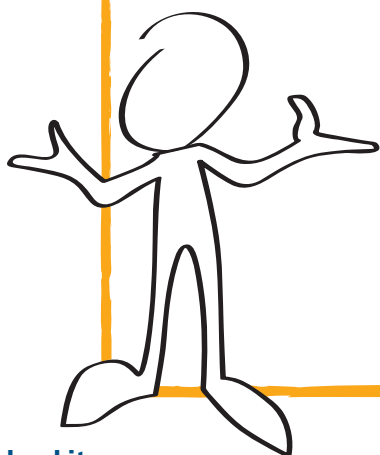
Ask your parents:
